Dear Residents

The seismic event that occurred in the early hours of January 2, 2018 whereby huge amounts of ice, earth and rocks moved causing extensive damage to the shoreline, private lands and parks within the Summer Village of Sunset Point. Council is aware of the extent of the damage and has visited the affected areas.

Consequently, the residents and the Summer Village of Sunset Point will be faced with huge cleanup costs and expense to rectify the damage. It will require not only equipment and machinery to remedy the damage, but help from various agencies to complete the cleanup properly. Assessments will be required to assess the extent of the damages to buildings and shorelines.

Council has sent letters to Municipal Affairs Minister Shay Anderson, Oneil Carlier, Minister of Agriculture and Forestry, and Jim Eglinski, Member of Parliament requesting help and expertise to how best to remediate and help our residents with the cleanup and restoration of our village as we recover from this extraordinary event.

Council asks that you watch the website for any updates and information regarding this matter. We will also post any correspondence and updates received from the various ministries.
