MINISTERIAL ORDER

ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SUNSET POINT

Whereas, the undersigned being satisfied that all requirements with respect to the incorporation of a Summer Village under the provisions of The Town and Village Act, chapter 338 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, and amendments thereto, have been substantially complied with, it is hereby ordered that the area described hereunder, namely:

Settlement Lot 20, and all that portion of the Hudson Bay Reserve lying west of the west boundary of the now abandoned railway right of way as shown on right of way plan 6054 A0; as shown on the plan of survey of Lake Ste. Anne Settlement in township 54, range 3, west of the fifth meridian approved and confirmed at Ottawa, the 9th of April, 1914:

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.

Be and it is hereby withdrawn from the Municipal District of Lac Ste. Anne No. 93 and erected into a Summer Village to be known as the Summer Village of Sunset Point.

It is further ordered that the nomination meeting for the first election of a council be held between the hours of seven o'clock and eight o'clock in the evening of June 13th, 1959, for the purpose of receiving names of candidates for the office of councillor.

It is further ordered that, if an election is necessary the polling day shall be Saturday, June 27th, 1959, and the election shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, chapter 338 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, in that behalf.

It is further ordered that the first meeting of the new council shall be held on Saturday, July 4th, 1959, at seven-thirty o'clock in the evening.

It is further ordered that Leonard Lawrence Gurel, Senior Municipal Inspector, be and is hereby appointed Official Administrator of the village from its erection on January 1st, 1959, to the first meeting of the new council and that he shall have full power and authority to make all arrangements necessary for the election above ordered.

This order shall be deemed to have been in effect as on and from the 1st day of January, 1959, except that for the purpose of Certificates of Assessment as required by sections 284 and 297 of The School Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, and section 110 of The Municipal Hospitals Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, this order shall be deemed to have been in effect as of the 31st day of December, 1958.
